EVENT OVERVIEW

YWCA Cambridge is partnering with Longwood Symphony Orchestra (LSO) as the beneficiary for their May 11, 2024 Concert, "Transfiguration with Longwood Chorus". All sponsorships and 100% of ticket sales made through YWCA Cambridge's ticket code will support our critical programming and the individuals we serve.

ATTENDANCE & REACH

On average the LSO hosts 400-500 guests per concert from Cambridge and surrounding areas. YWCA Cambridge promotes the event in print and digitally via Facebook and Instagram, platforms which have 1,600+ followers each. Each sponsor will be mentioned on our social media channels leading up to the event. Additionally, sponsors will be featured on 3-4 email blasts leading up to the concert, reaching over 2,000 individuals.

WHY YOUR SUPPORT MATTERS

- Founded in 1892, YWCA Cambridge is one of the oldest and largest providers of affordable housing for women in the Cambridge area. In 2023, we housed **181** people at our Tanner Residence and Renae's Place for Homeless Families, many of whom received stable housing through collaboration and support from staff.
- 100% of the women and families in our residences have income below the poverty line.
- In 2023, YWCA Cambridge served **700+** people through ongoing and one-time initiatives devoted to empowering women and eliminating racism.
- YWCA Cambridge's Youth Leadership programming uniquely serves girls, nonbinary, and transgender youth in the Cambridge community through two programs, Girls Only Leadership Development (GOLD) and GEY (Gender Expansive Youth). In 2023, we supported **35 youth** in year-long programs, cultivating their social activism skills while uplifting their intersectional identities.
